- 1) The divisions and sections of Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDA) were notified on 14<sup>th</sup> February, 2018. Subsequently, an exercise was undertaken to define the structure of each Division in consultation with the Head of the Division.

- 4) In case of any differences on the allocation of area of responsibility amongst sections or offices of the Mobility Division involving an interpretation of this notification, such difference shall be settled by the Advisor (Mobility) with the concurrence of the Chief Executive Officer.
- 5) The number and and qualifications of employees in the Mobility Division shall be in accordance with the rules notified under sub-section (1) of section 10 of the GMDA Act, 2017.
